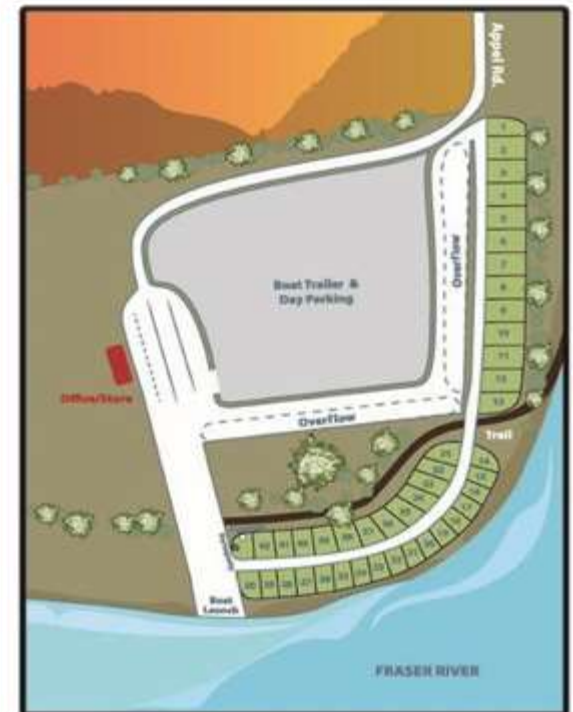
The Fraser River offers access to the largest and healthiest salmon, sturgeon and trout fishing in the world.



### Campground

The campground at the Cheam Fishing Village offers 42 spacious campsites along the Fraser River for day, night, weekly or season rentals.

## 2019 Campground Season Rates

Riverfront Camp Site	\$40 / Night
Standard Camp Site	\$30 / Night
Overflow Site	\$25 / Night

### Other:

- Day Use \$20
  - Boat Launch \$10 / Day
  - Boat Launch \$100 / Season
  - Additional Tent \$20 / Night
  - Extra Parking \$10
  - Extra Person \$5
  - Pet (on leash) \$5
- Must be 19 years or older to reserve campsite
  - A valid credit card & email address must be provided at time of booking
  - Minimum 3-night stay required over a long weekend
  - Reservations must be made at least 24 hours prior to stay
  - Pack-In Pack-Out ALL Garbage
  - Senior and Disability discounts
  - One vehicle per site, all additional vehicles will be charged for extra parking



## Fishing & Camping

In July, fish for Sturgeon, Chinook, and Trout while in the month of August, fish for Sturgeon, Chinook, Trout, Sockeye and Pink Salmon.

- Head East on Highway 7 (1km)
- Turn South on McDonald Road (0.1km) and then East on McDonald Road (0.4km)
- Turn South on Appel Road (1km)
- Arrive at the Cheam Fishing Village
