- ◆ Fish the white sturgeon, an ancient fish that boasts the biggest and oldest fish ever caught on rod in the Fraser River.

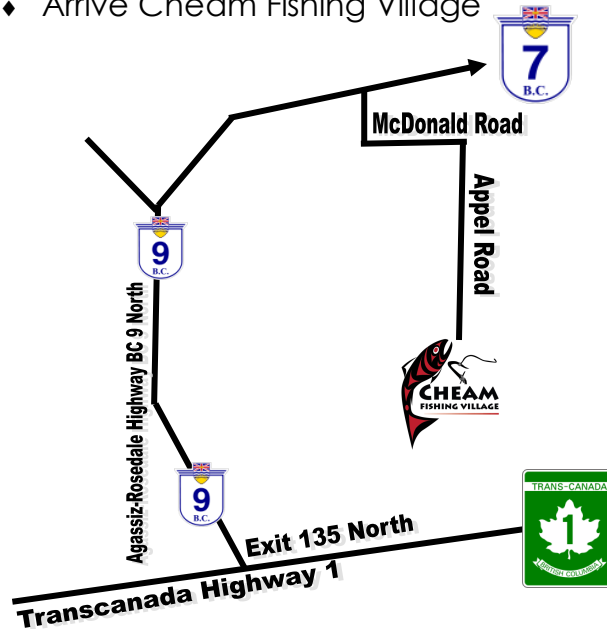
